1. Know your audience; dress properly

6. Invest in a remote clicker and thank me later :-)
7. The 20-minutes rule (break up the tone of your voice)
8. Don't write a novel on your PowerPoint
9. Try not to kill your audience with death by Power Point
10. Tell stories vs stats
